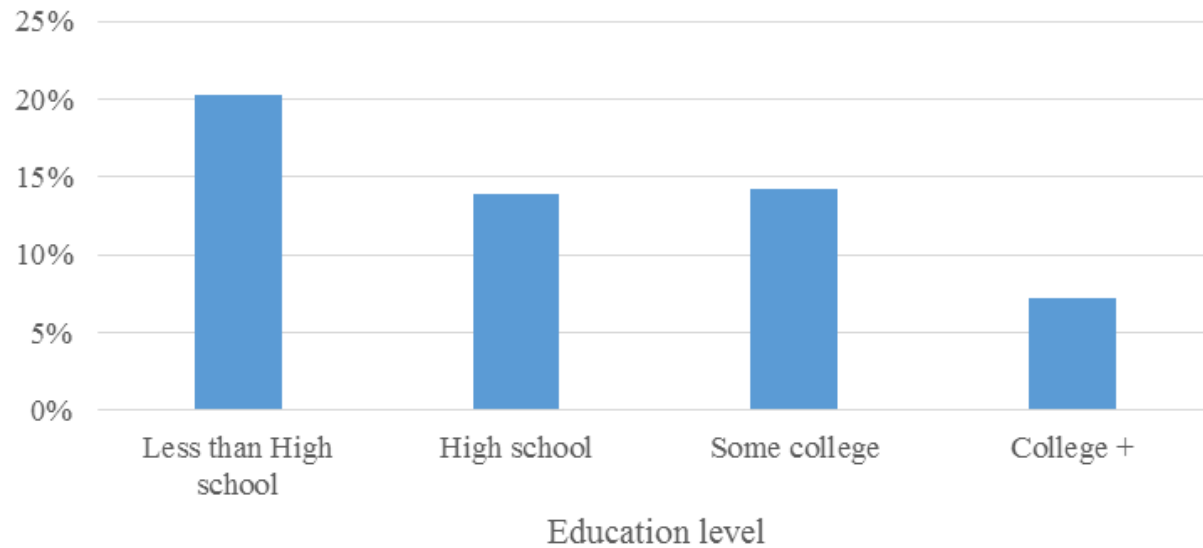

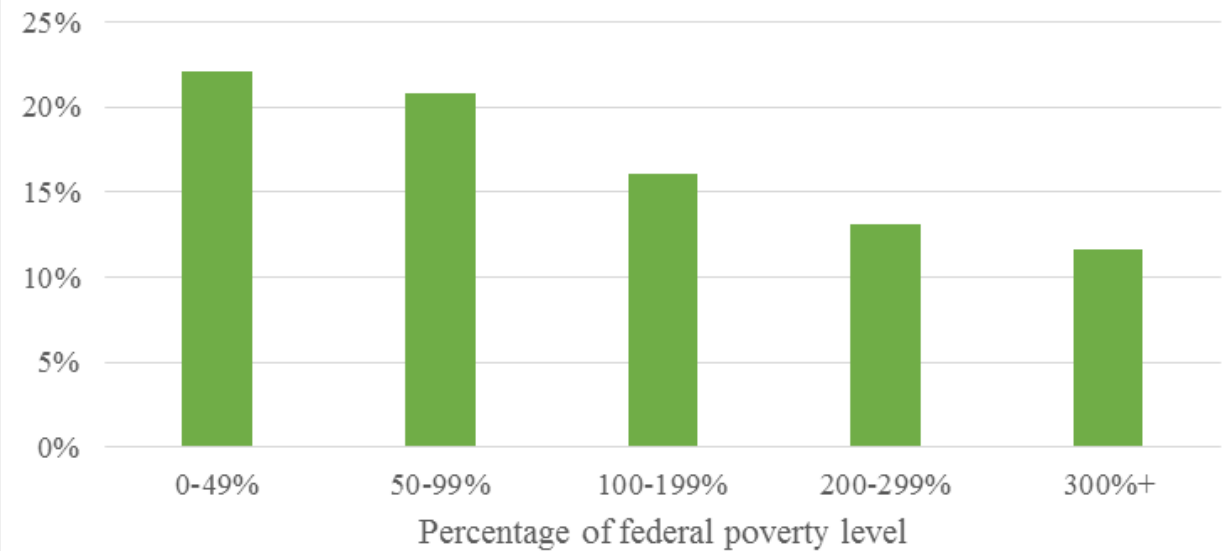
- Key predictors of interest:

DISADVANTAGED GO TO JAIL FOR CHILD SUPPORT DEBT

Percentage ever in jail for child support nonpayment by poverty



RESULTS & IMPLICATIONS

- Low Education → Jail
 - Explanation: Disadvantage
- Dad's MPF → Jail
 - Explanation: Poor relationship
- Effectiveness for child support enforcement policy?
- Role of moms in child support enforcement process?
